The Borough Clerk is hereby directed to submit a copy of this adopted Resolution, along with an executed Agreement, to Randolph Township as Lead Agency of the MCCPC. The Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to perform all required acts to affect the purpose of this Resolution.
