RESOLUTION NO. 06-13-16-03a RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET TO PROVIDE PARTICIPATION IN A COOPERATIVE MEANS OF CONDUCTING CERTAIN COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AND HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS, Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 provides for substantial federal funds being made available to certain urban counties for use therein; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant Program and the HOME Investment Partnership Programs have benefited the County as a whole and have provided a unique opportunity for intermunicipal cooperation and

WHEREAS, the program has provides substantial benefits to persons of low and moderate income including the elderly and disabled, and that these benefits would be lost without a renewal of the County cooperation agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield desires to preserve benefits of the Community Development Block Grant Program and the Home Investment Partnership Programs for the County by renewing its participation in the Somerset County Community Development Consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Services Act (N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq.) provides a mechanism through which counties and municipalities may enter into agreements for the provision of joint services; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq. provides that authorization for participation in such a cooperative program must be by resolution:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, New Jersey, that the Borough of North Plainfield:

1. does hereby authorize continued participation in the Somerset County Community Development Consortium or Urban County.
2. does hereby authorize, ratify and confirm a certain agreement (hereinafter referred to as "Contract") between the Borough of North Plainfield and Somerset County entitled "Agreement Between the County of Somerset and Certain Municipalities Located Therein For the Establishment of Cooperative Means of Conducting Certain Community Development Activities" and is further authorized to amend language that is contained in the existing agreement to comply with new requirements from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

This agreement shall automatically renew in every successive qualification period unless notice that it wishes to withdraw is provided to HUD and Somerset County.

It hereby authorizes full participation by the Borough of North Plainfield in all aspects of the activities provided for within said Contract pursuant to the terms and conditions as more fully set forth in said Contract.

3. It hereby incorporates said Agreement into this Resolution by reference, as if fully set forth herein.
4. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Contract with the County and Copy of said Contract will remain filed in the Office of the Municipal Clerk for public inspection.

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is in need of certain Road Improvements to Grove Street (hereinafter referred to as the “Project”); and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield solicited public bids for the Project and eight (8) bids were received and opened on the due date of May 26, 2016. The following three (3) were the lowest responsible bids:

WHEREAS, Grotto Engineering Associates, LLC, the Borough’s consulting engineer supervising on this Project, has reviewed the bid submissions and has recommended the award of the bid and contract for the Project to S. Brothers Inc., whose main offices are located at 16 Sobechko Road, Manalapan, New Jersey 07724 (hereinafter referred to as the “Contractor”); and,

WHEREAS, Director of Law/Borough Attorney Eric M. Bernstein, Esq., and the offices of Eric M. Bernstein & Associates, LLC, have reviewed the bid submissions and find no material defect with the bid proposal for the Contractor; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is desirous of obtaining the services of the Contractor to perform all those services contemplated in the Borough’s bid documents and the bid proposal submitted by the Contractor; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield finds that the Contractor is the lowest responsible bidder for the Project pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council hereby awards the following Bid and Contract:

Successful Bidder: S. Brothers Inc.

Total Bid: In the Amount of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars and Thirty-Two Cents (\$280,468.32).

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is in need of certain capital road improvements on various streets throughout the Borough (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and,

WHEREAS, Grotto Engineering Associates, LLC, the Borough's consulting engineer supervising this Project, has reviewed the bid submissions and has recommended the award of the bid and contract for the Project to Top Line Construction Corp., with its main offices located at 22 Fifth Street, Somerville, New Jersey 08876 (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor"); and,

WHEREAS, Director of Law/Borough Attorney Eric M. Bernstein, Esq., and the offices of Eric M. Bernstein & Associates, LLC have reviewed the bid submissions and find no material defect with the bid proposal for the Contractor; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is desirous of obtaining the services of the Contractor to perform all those services contemplated in the Borough's bid documents and the bid proposal submitted by the Contractor; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield finds that the Contractor is the lowest responsible bidder for the Project.
