**BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD

STATE OF NEW JERSEY**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE AND SUPPLEMENT
THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTH PLAINFIELD,
CHAPTER VII ENTITLED, "TRAFFIC,"
SECTION 7-4 ENTITLED,
"LIMITING THE USE OF STREETS TO CERTAIN CLASS OF VEHICLES,"
MOST NOTABLY,
SCHEDULE VI, ENTITLED
"TRUCKS OVER FOUR TONS."**

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey believes that it is in the best interest of the Borough to amend, revise and supplement Section 7-4 of the Borough Code of the Borough of North Plainfield, entitled "Limiting the Use of Streets to Certain Class of Vehicles"; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey is authorized by State law to make rules limiting the use of streets to certain classes of vehicles based upon weight within the Borough of North Plainfield; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey has determined that the public health, welfare and safety are protected by prohibiting the use of vehicles over four (4) tons (8000 lbs.) on certain streets within the geographic boundaries of the Borough of North Plainfield.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that Schedule VI of Chapter VII, Section 7-4.1 of the Borough Code of the Borough of North Plainfield, entitled "Trucks Over Four (4) Tons Excluded From Certain Streets," is hereby amended, revised and supplemented by prohibiting trucks over four (4) tons (8000 lbs.) on the following streets as set forth in Schedule VI below:

SCHEDULE VI, TRUCKS OVER FOUR TONS

In accordance with the provisions of subsection 7-4.1, trucks over four (4) tons gross weight (8000 lbs.) are excluded from the following described streets or parts of streets.

SCHEDULE VI, TRUCKS OVER FOUR TONS	
<i>Name of Street</i>	<i>Location</i>
Clinton Avenue	North of Greenbrook to dead end.
Columbia Avenue	Between U.S. Route 22 and Greenbrook Road.

Duer Street	From its intersection with Howard Street to its intersection with the northerly curb line of Craig Place.
Farragut Road	Between Brook Avenue and Mountain Avenue.
Grove Street	From its intersection with Route 22 to its intersection with the northerly curb line of Craig Place and between Ridge Avenue and Interhaven Avenue.
Harrison Avenue	Between Ridge Avenue and Interhaven Avenue.
<u>Harrison Avenue</u>	<u>Between U.S. Route 22 and Greenbrook Road.</u>
<u>Jefferson Avenue</u>	<u>Between U.S. Route 22 and Greenbrook Road.</u>
Johnston Drive	The entire length east of Watchung Avenue.
Maple Avenue	Between Greenbrook Road and Route 22.
North Drive	Between Route 22 and Mountain Avenue.
Norwood Avenue	Between Brook Avenue and Mountain Avenue.
Parkview Avenue	Between Harding Avenue and Clinton Avenue.
Sandford Avenue	Between Brook Avenue and Mountain Avenue.
Taft Avenue	Between Rock Avenue and Harding Avenue.
Warfield Road	From Clinton Avenue east to West End Avenue.
Westervelt Avenue	Between Brook Avenue and Mountain Avenue.
Wilson Avenue	Between Ridge Avenue and Interhaven Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that:

- Proper signage shall be erected after receipt of any approvals required pursuant to state or county regulations and requirements.
- All ordinances or portions of ordinances that are inconsistent with this Ordinance shall be repealed as to their inconsistencies only.

- If any provision or paragraph of this Ordinance shall be held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other provisions or paragraphs of this Ordinance, except so far as the provision or paragraph so declared invalid shall be separable from the remainder or any portion thereof.
- This Ordinance shall take effect, after final passage, twenty (20) days following action or inaction by the Mayor as provided by law or an override of a mayoral veto by the Council, whichever is applicable and publication in accordance with law, unless a resolution is adopted, pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181(b)*, declaring an emergency and providing that this Ordinance shall take effect at an earlier date.
